

Crochet Rainbow Mittens

Yarn:

7 Bröder Raita rainbow (nr 822)

7 Bröder black (nr 099)

This is a yarn from Finland, if you need to replace it with something else this yarn is 100 meter/50 g skein.

You need 85 g black and 25 g self-stripping yarn.

Needle:

4 mm

Abbreviations (US terms)

ch - chain

sl st - slip stitch

sc - single crochet

dc - double crochet

st - stitch

prev - previous

tog - together

8 sc (or any other number) means 1 sc in each stitch as many times as the number says



Wristlet

all stitches in back loop only

ch 11

1-34: ch 1, 11 sc, turn

fold the wristlet, slip-stitch together at wrong side. Turn the right side out and start with the mitten.

Mitten

First sc in same stitch as ch in the black rounds unless other stated

1: 34 sc around, sl st in first st (34)

2: ch 1, 8 sc, 2 sc in 1, 16 sc, 2 sc in 1, 8 sc, sl st in first st (36)

3: change colour, ch 1, skip 3 st, 5 dc in same st, *ch 1, skip 5 st, 5 dc in same st* x 5, sl st around 1st ch (36)

4: change colour, 1 sc in the st below ch/sl st from prev round, 1 sc in each of the 5 dc, *1 sc in the st below the ch, 1 sc in each of the 5 dc* x 5, sl st in first st (36)

5: ch 1, 1 sc in each st, sl st in first st (36)

6: change colour, ch 3, 2 dc in same st, *ch 1, skip 5 st, 5 dc in same st* x 5, ch 1, 2 dc in the same st as the first 2 dc+3 ch, 1 sl st at the top of ch 3 (36)

7: change colour, ch 1, 1 sc, 1 sc in each of the 2 dc, *1 sc in the st below the ch, 1 sc in each of the 5 dc* x 5, 1 sc in the st below the ch, 1 sc in each of the 2 dc, sl st in first st (36)

8: ch 1, 1 sc in each st, sl st in first st (36)

9: change colour, ch 1, skip 3 st, 5 dc in same st, *ch 1, skip 5 st, 5 dc in same st* x 5, sl st around 1st ch (36)

10: change colour, 1 sc in the st below ch/sl st from prev round, 1 sc in each of the 5 dc, *1 sc in the st below the ch, 1 sc in each of the 5 dc* x 5, sl st in first st (36)

11: *left mitten* ch 1, 3 sc, ch 7, skip 7 st, 1 sc in each st, sl st in first st (36)

11: *right mitten* ch 1, 27 sc, ch 7, skip 7 st, 2 sc, sl st in first st (36)

12: change colour, ch 3, 2 dc in same st, *ch 1, skip 5 st, 5 dc in same st* x 5, ch 1, 2 dc in the same st as the first 2 dc+3 ch, 1 sl st at the top of ch 3 (36)

13: change colour, ch 1, 1 sc, 1 sc in each of the 2 dc, *1 sc in the st below the ch, 1 sc in each of the 5 dc* x 5, 1 sc in the st below the ch, 1 sc in each of the 2 dc, sl st in first st (36)

14: ch 1, 1 sc in each st, sl st in first st (36)

15-26: repeat round 3-8 two times

27: change colour, ch 1, skip 3 st, 5 dc in same st, *ch 1, skip 5 st, 5 dc in same st* x 5, sl st around 1st ch (36)

28: change colour, 1 sc in the st below ch/sl st from prev round, 1 sc in each of the 5 dc, *1 sc in the st below the ch, 1 sc in each of the 5 dc* x 5, sl st in first st (36)

Now work in spirals

29: sc in next st, 6 sc, 2 sc tog, 16 sc, 2 sc tog, 9 sc (34)

30: 7 sc, 2 sc tog, 15 sc, 2 sc tog, 8 sc (32)

31: 7 sc, 2 sc tog, 14 sc, 2 sc tog, 7 sc (30)

32: 7 sc, 2 sc tog, 13 sc, 2 sc tog, 6 sc (28)

33: 7 sc, 2 sc tog, 12 sc, 2 sc tog, 5 sc (26)

34: 6 sc, 2 sc tog x 2, 9 sc, 2 sc tog x 2, 3 sc (22)

35: 5 sc, 2 sc tog x 2, 7 sc, 2 sc tog x 2, 2 sc (18)

36: 4 sc, 2 sc tog x 2, 5 sc, 2 sc tog x 2, 1 sc (14)

sew together

Tumme

Work in spirals

1: 18 sc around the thumbhole

2-12: 1 sc i varje st (18)

13: (4 sc, 2 tog) x 3 (15)

14: (3 sc, 2 tog) x 3 (12)

15: (2 sc, 2 tog) x 3 (9)

16: 2 tog x 3 (6)

sew together

Fasten off!
